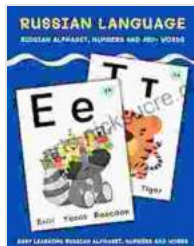

## Russian Numbers

The Russian number system is very similar to the English number system. The numbers from 0 to 10 are as follows:

- 0 - нуль (nul)
- 1 - один (odin)
- 2 - два (dva)
- 3 - три (tri)
- 4 - четыре (chetyre)
- 5 - пять (pyat)
- 6 - шесть (shest)
- 7 - семь (sem)

- 8 - восемь (vosem)
- 9 - девять (devyat)
- 10 - десять (desyat)

The numbers from 11 to 19 are formed by adding the word "надцать" (natsat) to the number from 1 to 9. For example, 11 is "одиннадцать" (odinnadtsat), 12 is "двенадцать" (dvenadtsat), and so on.

The numbers from 20 to 99 are formed by adding the word "десять" (desyat) to the number from 2 to 9. For example, 20 is "двадцать" (dvadtsat), 30 is "тридцать" (tridtsat), and so on.

The numbers from 100 to 999 are formed by adding the word "сто" (sto) to the number from 1 to 9. For example, 100 is "сто" (sto), 200 is "двести" (dvesti), and so on.

The numbers from 1,000 to 9,999 are formed by adding the word "тысяча" (tysyacha) to the number from 1 to 9. For example, 1,000 is "тысяча" (tysyacha), 2,000 is "две тысячи" (dve tysyachi), and so on.

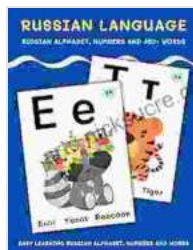

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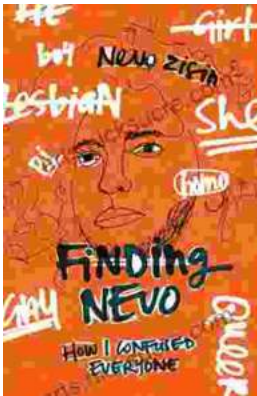
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
