

Ny Regents Prep Test United States History Government Flash Cards Cram Now

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Preparing for the Regents Exam in United States History and Government can be a daunting task. If they cannot correctly answer the question on a card, they move the card to Box 3. Students continue to review the cards in each box at increasing intervals. For example, they might review the cards in Box 1 every day, the cards in Box 2 every two days, the cards in Box 3 every three days, and so on.

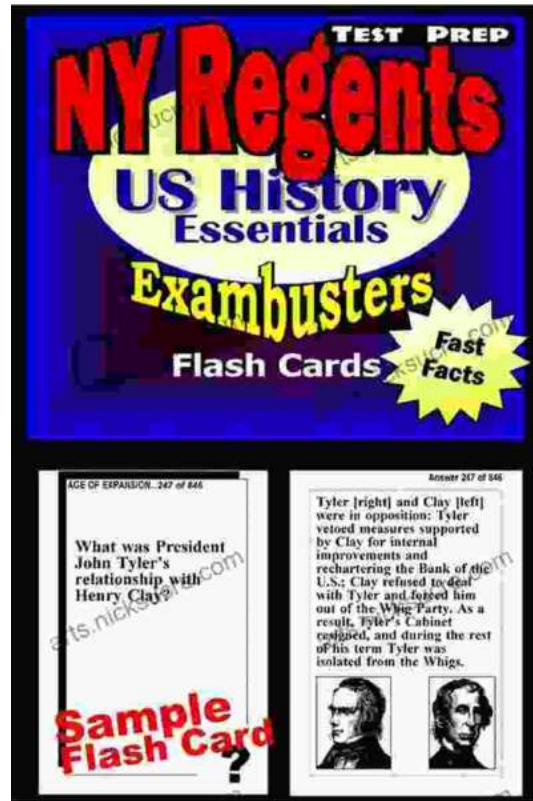
As students review the cards, they will eventually move all of the cards to Box 5. Once a card is in Box 5, it is considered to be mastered. Students can then remove the card from the stack and stop reviewing it.

The Leitner system is a powerful tool that can help students to memorize key facts and concepts. However, it is important to note that flashcards are just one tool that can be used to prepare for the Regents Exam in United States History and Government. In addition to using flashcards, students should also review their notes, take practice tests, and get plenty of rest.
