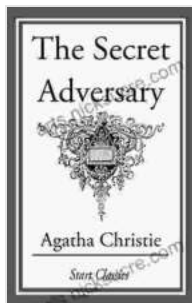


The Secret Adversary: A Tommy and Tuppence Mystery

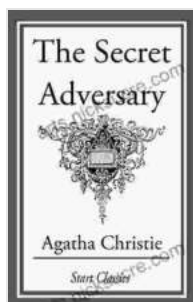

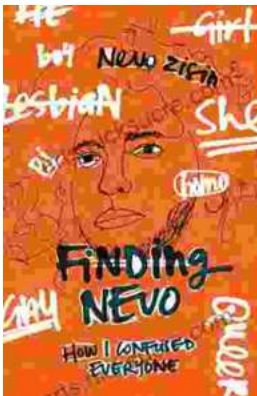
